## DEADLINE

Open all year.



## ALLOCATED AMOUNTS

- Same city: registration fees up to \$200.
- Different city and distance less than 250 km: registration and travelling fees up to \$400.
- Elsewhere in Canada and international: maximum of \$800.



## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be a student in dentistry or in another discipline, enrolled in a Master's, Doctoral or Postdoctoral program and working in collaboration with a regular member of the Network for Oral and Bone Health Research;
- Have an abstract accepted for a presentation at a national (Canadian) or international convention;
- Only one application per regular member may be submitted per year (i.e., a member may not apply for a student conference support for more than one student in the same year).



## CONDITIONS

Grant to a student for presentation of abstracts at national and international conventions: once a year.



## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- A letter signed by the student and his/her supervisor (Network member) confirming the supervisor/student relationship and that the student has or will present the abstract submitted.
- A document confirming acceptance of the abstract for presentation at a convention.
- It should be noted that the incurred expenses will be reimbursed upon presentation of an invoice from the supervisor, a proof of reimbursement to the student, and copies of invoices & receipts for the student.
