



**RECRUITMENT AID
FOR RESEARCHERS**

2016 INFORMATION DOCUMENT



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be in the midst of an active recruiting process or recruited up to 2 years ago with one of the Network's partner faculties;
- Be eligible for the status of regular member of the Network for Oral and Bone Health Research and have research interests compatible with the priorities of the Network's different lines of research;



CONDITIONS

- Only applications by Associate Deans (Research) will be accepted (i.e., an individual researcher must have his/her Associate Dean apply for him/her);
- The funds granted to a faculty for the recruitment of a candidate will be paid directly to the Associate Dean and must be returned to the RSBO if this candidate has not started his duties within the year of the grant.
- The funds granted to a faculty for the recruitment of a candidate who has already started his position will be paid to him directly, on the condition that he becomes a member of the RSBO.
- Only one application per faculty per year is accepted.



APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Submit a letter of two pages maximum (font Times New Roman 12 points, margin of 2 cm) indicating:

- The applicant's name;
- The applicant's field of expertise;
- The applicant's contribution in relation to the Network's mission and priorities;
- The way the money will be used.

Also submit the following document for the applicant:

- A copy of the applicant's biosketch (see description below).

In cases where the past accomplishments in research of the candidate are not very strong, the letter of the Associate Dean must provide a brief overview of the research program, describe precisely how the money will be spent (include a budget) and describe the type of support that the faculty will offer to this young researcher in order to help him (her) start his (her) research program and get established.
